



OVERNIGHT STAYCATION MODIFICATIONS DURING COVID-19

To maintain health & safety for participants and staff, Stepping Stones' Overnight Staycations will look a little different this year. Here are some modifications we have made for the 2020 season.

- **STAGGERED CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT:** To maintain a safety, we are staggering check-in and checkout times for participants.
- **CONTAINED CABIN GROUPS:** Cabin participants and their designated staff will enjoy activities and meals together throughout the week. To limit risk of exposure, cabin groups will not mix or interact with one another.
- **DAILY HEALTH CHECKS:** Upon arrival, each participant will have their temperature taken before joining their cabin. If his/her temperature is 100° F or higher, the participant will be sent home. Nursing staff will continue to monitor and assess each participant daily throughout the session. Staff will also have daily health checks.
- **SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS:** Beds are aligned so that participants and staff will sleep head to toe at least 6 feet apart.
- **OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES:** The majority of program activities will take place outdoors with shaded areas available.
- **RAINY DAY PLAN:** During rain or storms, cabin activities will move indoors with each cabin in a separate designated area. Groups will not mix or share space.
- **MEALTIMES:** Meals will be staggered for cabins and each participant will receive an individually labeled and plated meal that follows their dietary plan. No buffet-style dining.
- **BEHAVIOR CHALLENGES:** Stepping Stones reserves the right to send a participant home if his/her behavior becomes unmanageable, disruptive or endangers the health & safety of participants and staff.
- **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Cabin participants will space out in program areas, sitting six feet apart whenever possible.
- **NO LARGE GATHERINGS:** There will be no large gatherings or camp-wide evening activities this year to ensure groups maintain social distancing and proper hand hygiene.
- **NO OUTSIDE VISITORS:** To limit risk of exposure, outside visitors, program guests and volunteers are not permitted at camp this summer.
- **INCREASED CLEANING:** Stepping Stones is increasing cleaning of all high-touch areas regularly and will ensure adequate supplies are available at all times to minimize risk.
- **ISOLATION ROOM:** An isolation room has been set-up to separate anyone showing COVID-19 symptoms or other signs of illness.
